

## **IDSA Policy on its Clinical Practice Guidelines in Development**

### **Presentation or dissemination of *DRAFT* IDSA Guidelines**

#### ***IDSA Annual Meeting***

The Standards and Practice Guidelines Committee (SPGC) presents new, updated and draft (in development) guidelines to its members during the “Update on New Guidelines Symposium” held in conjunction with the IDSA Annual Meeting.

Draft guidelines **WILL NOT** be considered as definitive and/or final and **WILL NOT** be reproduced or disseminated in any form to/by unauthorized individuals or groups until fully vetted and approved by the IDSA (and its collaborators) and published. These draft recommendations are presented solely for the purposes of providing an opportunity for IDSA members to provide the development panel with valuable feedback regarding the draft guideline.

#### ***Non-IDSA Meetings and Industry-sponsored Symposia***

IDSA guidelines that are in development (i.e., they have not been reviewed and approved by IDSA or its collaborators) **WILL NOT** be presented at any meeting outside of the IDSA Annual Meeting SPGC-Sponsored Symposium.

#### ***Continuing Medical Education Activities***

IDSA Guidelines that are in development (i.e., they have not been reviewed and approved by IDSA or its collaborators) **WILL NOT** be used by any entity to develop and disseminate any continuing educational activity, tools or products.

### **Review of *Draft* IDSA Guidelines**

All IDSA guidelines are subjected to a rigorous and multi-level review and approval process prior to publication. Public review of draft guidelines is not permitted.

In an effort to maintain the integrity of the draft guideline, the IDSA will not divulge the panel members names during the guideline development process.
