COVID-19 Vaccine Update

- ➤ December 10: Vaccines and Biological Products Advisory Committee (VRBPAC) voted to recommend FDA emergency use authorization (EUA) of the Pfizer-BioNTech Vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19 in persons aged 16 or older
- > December 11: FDA issued EUA for the Pfizer-BioNTech Vaccine in persons aged 16 or older
- ➤ December 12: Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) meeting to discuss generate recommendations for its use
- ➤ December 17: VRBPAC meeting to discuss emergency use authorization of the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19 in individuals 18 years and older






